As ARC's new Board President, I'm pleased to share our 2023 Annual Impact Report. I've been serving as Development Chair on ARC's Board of Directors since November 2022 and was elected as Board President in January 2024.

As we reflect on 2023, and the work former Board President Justin Umagat accomplished along with current Board members, volunteers, and the ARC staff, we're thrilled to see our communities not only surviving, but thriving. Here are just some of our highlights from last year:

- ARC's administrative team made the exciting move to our new offices in Elliott Bay and hosted our first Open House with our partners and supporters, marking a new milestone in ARC's journey.
- In preparation for our 5th Annual Fund the Fun fundraising breakfast, we hosted our inaugural Leadership Luncheon with Tom Farrey, Executive Director of the Aspen Institute's Sports and Society Program, to discuss the importance of equity and the future of youth sports and recreation in the Puget Sound.
- ARC and our partner Seattle Parks and Recreation hosted our inaugural Seattle Slam
 Basketball tournament, activating downtown Seattle and letting our youth enjoy a weekend
 of free basketball under the Monorail.
- Swim Seattle, Mayor Bruce Harrell's drowning prevention and youth aquatics initiative, had a
 very successful launch year. ARC was one of several partners to offer free swim lessons,
 removing barriers to ensure our most vulnerable youth have the skills they need to be safe
 around Seattle's beautiful pools and open water.

Thanks to the support of our donors, volunteers, staff, and all our program and childcare participants, our ARC communities are stronger than ever. Your support has allowed Seattle's recreation, childcare, and lifelong learning programs to flourish – thank you for being part of our ARC family.




